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State requirements	NJ State requires one Certified Food Protection Manager per location. By 1/2/2010 -mandatory on a state level at least one person in charge in Risk Type 3 Food Establishment shall be a certified food protection manager who has shown proficiency of required information through obtaining a food safety certificate by passing a food safety certification examination administered by an accredited certifying program recognized by the Conference for Food Protection The person need not be present during all hours of operation, but several counties have CFPM requirements (see below)	ServSafe, NRFSP, and Prometric exams approved

City of South Plainfield	Required –Must have a Certified Food Protection Manager at each establishment	Hours of instruction 16hr ServSafe course approved, Recertification every 5 years
City of Wayne	Required-Every owner/manager of a food service establishment must be certified. At no time shall a food service establishment be without a certified manager. (Chester County Food Protection Regulations, Ch. 300)	Hours of instruction 16, recertification every 5 years
City of Hillsborough	Required – A certified manager must be on premises during business hours..	Hours of instruction 16, recertification every 3 years
