State requirements	<p>Rules and Regulations For Certification of Managers in Food Safety [R21-27-CFS] are promulgated pursuant to the authority conferred under chapters 23-1 and 21-27 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, as amended, and are established for the purpose of protecting Rhode Island consumers from foodborne illness.</p> <p>Each food establishment where potentially hazardous foods are prepared shall employ at least one certified full time, on-site manager who is at least 18 years of age. Establishments with 10 or more full-time employees must have at least 2 certified managers.</p>	ServSafe, NRFSP, and Prometric exams approved
